

edTPA Rendering Guide

- Although Premiere Elements is generally regarded as being more user friendly than Premiere Pro, this can only be done in Pro
- After trimming the videos together using the razor tool (C), go to File > Export > Media
- When the export dialog pops up, follow the instructions below:
